**Presbytery Council**  
Report to Presbytery  
November 10, 2009

Presbytery Council met on September 24, 2009, at First Presbyterian Church, Maple Plain, MN, and on October 22, 2009, at First Presbyterian Church Ellsworth, WI. The Council visited with the sessions of the host churches, including the session of Laurel Presbyterian Church, Hager City, WI, learning about the activities and worship life of the three congregations. At each meeting, Council was warmly welcomed, and bonds of relationship were established or strengthened. Council thanks those churches who have opened their doors to us. Council plans to meet in those churches who are unable to host Presbytery.

In September, Council approved the use of the new Mission Pledge Form. In October, some time was spent on discussion of the new web site, and the officers will be discussing this further. Council continues to work toward planning changes in the order of business for the docket, and a meeting on October 29 included conversations around this topic of worship and business.

At both meetings, Council spent some time in continuing its conversations around helping the Presbytery define its goals and priorities for the future. More about this will be forthcoming.
